# Original Charge from Scott Fleming

- enhance nimbleness in bringing new degree programs to Council for decision;
- lower threshold for approval of new degree programs; and
- raise threshold for post-approval evaluation of degree programs (program productivity).

### **Consultations**

- Academic Affairs Committee: October 2024
- Public Institution Chief Academic Officers: September 2024, November 2024, January 2025, and March 2025
- Secretary of Education: February and March 2024
- Virginia Office of Education Economics (VOEE): throughout 2024

#### **Outcome: New Guidance Document**

- "New Degree Program Approval Guidance Document"
  - The Guidance Document constitutes a self-contained policy for institutions proposing <u>new</u> degree programs.
  - The reforms embodied in the document are focused on the two green-highlighted bullets above.

## Reforms – 1

- Elimination of Program Announcement
- Elimination/reduction of specific information requirements:
  - Learning Outcomes (eliminated)
  - Job ads (eliminated)
  - Duplication (reduced)
  - Labor Market information: VOEE data report <u>substitutes for</u> Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) and Virginia Employment Commission (VEC)

#### Reforms – 2

- Additions:
  - Proposed new degree programs <u>must</u> be included in most recent sixyear plan
  - Return on Investment
- Process truncation: SCHEV staff substantive review will have <u>one</u> stage (no back and forth)
