

Summary of the Amendments over the Governor's Budget In 2024-26 Biennium

On February 20, 2025, the Conference Committee reported their budget amendments over the Governor's introduced budget amendments in 2024-26 biennium.

Items related to all state employees:

Compensation:

- Provides a one-time bonus for full-time employees in FY 2026.
- 1.5% of base salary

Tax Relief:

- Tax rebate: \$200 for single filers and \$400 for joint filers.
- Standard deductions: increase \$250 (single filers) and \$500 (joint filers) for a total of \$8,750 (single filers) and \$17,500 (joint filers) for tax years of 2025 and 2026.
