

State Council of Higher Education Passport and Uniform Certificate of General Studies (UCGS) Waiver Request Form

(Updated April 30, 2025)

Code of Virginia § 23.1-907(C) allows institutions to seek a waiver "...from the Council from accepting the transfer of a UCGS Program or Passport Program course to satisfy the requirements for the completion of a specific pathway or degree." Any such waiver must be approved by SCHEV and shall not apply across the board to all programs or pathways, i.e. each waiver request must be tailored to a specific program or pathway. Please note, waivers for exclusion from the Passport or UCGS in its entirety will not be granted. The <u>Virginia Public Higher Education Policy on Passport and Uniform Certificate of General Studies Programs</u> outlines applicability, elements, and the submission process for institutions seeking a Passport or UCGS course waiver.
