




What Does a Cardinal Education Student Look Like?






Enrollments by Ethnicity








Starting to see some expansion in the geographic reach over the past two years.



Enrollment in online graduate engineering continues to grow, driven by additional program offerings


Online Graduate Engineering Enrollments





Cardinal Education has expanded its course offerings to 350+ per year





Online Graduate Engineering Degrees (Cardinal Education)






Impacts on Wage and Employment
